SPEAKER NICHOL: Any further discussion on the bill? If not, the question is the advancement of the bill. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted that care to? Four are excused. Have you all voted? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I guess I need to request a call of the house and call in vote.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We're still under call.

SENATOR WARNER: I guess I didn't mean that.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Roll call vote. All right. The question is the advancement of the bill. Mr. Clerk, roll call vote.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken as found on page 2377 of the Legislative Journal.) 25 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. The call is raised, but may I introduce some guests in the south balcony. Senator Lynch has 28 fourth graders from Ponca Elementary School in Omaha and their teacher. Would you please...I guess you're leaving, huh? Well, thank you for coming. We appreciate it. Also Senator Goodrich has Judge Colleen Bukley of the juvenile court in Omaha under the south balcony. Would you please stand, Judge, and be recognized. Thank you for visiting us today. Move on to 501, please.
