It will not be subject to this amendment offered by Senator DeCamp, which cuts across the board. These other items will be subject to the cut. But an attempt can be made to justify their being exempted. If enough votes can be obtained to justify the exemption, then they are exempted. So that is what the amendment would do. I hope that you'll adopt it. I hope I didn't make a mistake by taking it all as a package instead of one at a time, as I had originally thought to do.
