

PRESIDENT: Senator Labeledz.

SENATOR LABEDZ: Thank you, Mr. President. You will notice the fiscal note of \$600,000. As I promised on Select File we'll see how the appropriation bill goes. I may introduce an amendment myself to reduce that. At this time I can't tell you how much, but as I said before, it is very deceiving when I get my county assessor saying that if this bill doesn't go through the state will save some money because so many people will go back on the tax rolls. But unfortunately we don't have the right figures from Douglas County. The last figure I got they would save \$50,000, the state, but I know that Sarpy County increased their actual valuations and so did Lancaster County, so I don't know if those three counties were taken into consideration because many of them will go back on the tax rolls even if this bill passes. As I said, their homes were increased far more than \$45,000. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion on 556A? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. After you vote the call of the house is raised, you having had the opportunity to vote, the call of the house is raised. Please record your vote on the advancement of 556A.
