SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move that LB 717A be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance 717A, the appropriation bill. Is there discussion? If not, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting to advance LB 717A from Select File to Enrollment and Review for Engrossment. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 717A, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 717A is advanced. Now then, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill for consideration is LB 154. LB 154 had been on Final Reading. There was a motion by Senator Warner and Wesely to return the bill for a specific amendment. That amendment was found on page 2336. The bill was returned to Select File for that specific amendment. That amendment is now before us.
