

women, the aged, and so forth, this Legislature makes sure that that kind of legislation does not pass. Sometimes a person speaking as Senator DeCamp did, without saying the words, are adopting the position which those of us who are situated in a disadvantaged position, the arrogant words, if I were in your position, this is what I would do. I would want this commission abolished but the fact is you are not in my position. You do not understand what it is we contend with. We know that these commissions are ineffective. We know they are not designed to do the job that needs doing but something needs to be there on which to build. In the same way some of the people on this legislative floor do not understand the ferment out there among the white farmers who are their constituents, they have no idea of the bubbling undercurrents of potential violence among these various groups who have been kept on the outside all the time. John F. Kennedy said those who make peaceful evolution impossible make violent revolution inevitable. The word "revolution" does not necessarily mean you think you are going to overthrow the government and substitute something in its place. It means you have been pushed to the wall and there is no other alternative. The only thing left by which you can vindicate your manhood, your personhood is violence.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Violence is the only thing left to you. You are taking away the only thing that might serve as a safety valve, the thing that people such as myself might use to con other people and say, look, the state is trying to make it possible to do something. We have got the skeletal framework, maybe we can build on it. You want to take even that little away and you are doing it because you say this paper is sacrosanct. This must be preserved at all costs. But you let it be something related to the bankers, and you will scramble, you will suspend the rules, you will cut off debate, you will pervert the entire legislative process for the bankers. But now this paper is holy. It is a dodge. It is a sham. It is a false argument, and if you do not adopt this amendment, all I can say is that it is a shame. This won't hurt me, personally, but in the long run it can create problems that you don't envision. Some of these agencies grew out of the problems that came about in the sixties when people were resorting to the streets and using their bodies and violence when those were the only things left to them.
