I am not going to just distribute it in this state. I am going to distribute it all over the country to all of the people I have contacts with.

PRESIDENT: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Those legislators who have written to me, those people who work with foundations, those who work with churches, all these organizations can show in 1985 what a racist Legislature there is here talking about they have got to cut \$15 million off a budget so they are going to take \$100,000 from...to destroy these agencies for that piddling amount but they are not going to touch the white big ticket items. You are teaching me a great deal about you but you learn nothing about me. I am around you all the time. I watch you all the time. You tell on each other to me. I think one day I am going to write a book about this Legislature and I am going to name names and give dates. Those of you who know you have been tipping where you shouldn't be tipping, you know who you are, and you know where you have been tipping to, don't you? And you know some of the things you do, and you know some of the things you say to these youngsters. You know and I know because they tell me and I am going to write in my book unless some of you all can kill me first, but you see you can't kill me by voting me out of existence like you can pick off these little agencies. I will stand up to you and I will fight you and I will fight you with everything at my disposal. I think you have been unfair to the Mexican-American Commission. I think you are about to be unfair to the Indian Commission, but as they say about Montezuma, I will have my, and mixing it in with Shakespeare, pound of flesh before it is over but I still hope you will look at what you would do by destroying this commission and that you will let it live.
