SPEAKER NICHOL: It is advanced...what?

SENATOR PIRSCH: I would just like to put on the record and have the press take note and particularly Nancy Hicks, who printed Senator Haberman's statement that I swapped votes or inferred that I traded votes, that that was untrue and the proof was certainly demonstrated tonight. I did want to clear up that misstatement that was in the paper. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Thank you. The call is raised. Yes. The call is raised. Senator Sieck. Say it again. You weren't turned on.
