Some are wishing to amend LB 722 which we'll take up after while, today, so that we can still get it done...still get the amending done, if any amending is done, and get it up for Final Reading Tuesday so we will have a chance for override on Wednesday. If we wait until Monday to revise 722, we will not have time to get it back in time for reading until Wednesday, and that will be too late for any overrides if you wish. So what we will do is to go on with the appropriation bills that are left that have not been advanced to Final Reading, and then come back to 722 so that any of you...if you wish to attempt to amend 722 today, you'll have an opportunity to do so. We'll do that before we go on to Select File, on the back of the page. So that will give you a chance to amend 722, if you wish to do so, today after we get through the other select appropriation bills. With that, we will move on to LB 724. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign, and do sign LB 496, LB 614, LB 606A, LB 606, LB 389. I would like to recognize Senator Hoagland in as much as he has a special guest. We'd like to explain about his special guest, introduce him, and tell you how you may meet with him today.
