SPEAKER NICHOL: All right, please check your green button. Will you please look up and push your green button so I don't have to call your name. Please look up and punch your green button. Senator Harris, Senator Lamb, Senator Baack, Senator Rod Johnson, Senator Lundy, Senator Barrett, Senator Nelson. Senator Baack, Senator Barrett, please turn off your speaking lights. Everybody is here and you wished a roll call vote and the question is, shall the bill be returned? Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Read the roll call vote as found on pages 2662-63 of the Legislative Journal.) 19 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is not returned. Do you have anything else on the bill?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Please read the bill.

CLERK: (Read LB 717 on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2663 of the Legislative Journal.) 29 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President, on 717.

SPEAKER NICHOL: 717 advances or is passed. LB 717A.

CLERK: (Read LB 717A on Final Reading.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall 717A pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read the record vote as found on page 2664 of the Legislative Journal.) The vote is 33 ayes, 14 nays, 2 present and not voting.
