PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the resolution as amended? If not, the motion is to adopt LR 250. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all recorded your vote? Please record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of LR 250, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LR 250 is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senator Haberman and Vard Johnson to suspend Rule 6, Section 5 and adopt 259, 260, 266, 274, 275, 278, 279, 280, 281, 282, 283, 284, 287, 288, 291 and 293.

PRESIDENT: Senator Haberman or Johnson.

SENATOR HABERMAN: Mr. President, that is all but the last three, which they want to talk about on the floor.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on the motion, this motion to suspend the rules to take up all these resolutions in one vote? Is there further discussion? All right then the motion is to suspend the rules to consider all these named resolutions on one vote. All those in favor...294, 95 and 96 are not included in this motion. Motion to suspend the rules to do this...for this purpose. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all recorded your vote on the motion to suspend the rules to take up a number of resolutions at once? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to suspend the rules, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The rules are now suspended. Now for the vote on the combined number of resolutions. Is there discussion on the mass adoption motion? If not, the motion is to adopt all these resolutions from 259 through 293 (sic). All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted on the resolutions? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.
