Unauthorized personnel, please leave the floor but please record your presence before you leave your desk. Senator Lamb, record your presence, please. Thank you. Senator Sieck, Senator Higgins, Senator Landis, Senator Haberman. Yes, sir.

SENATOR LAMB: Is Senator Beutler supposed to be in his seat? How about Senator Hoagland, is he supposed to be in his seat?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Haberman. Senator Higgins, will you record your presence please. Senator Rod Johnson we are looking for. Senator Rod Johnson is here. A roll call vote has been asked for and the question is reconsideration of 157. Roll call vote, Mr. Clerk.
