

for terms...purposes of vesting the employer contributions made after the reentry under subsection (3), the years of participation shall include years of participation prior to such employee's original termination. So what we're actually doing is allowing an employee that terminates and comes back to come back with some ability to have the benefits. And then we have on another part of the amendment another, more or less, a bookkeeping type thing. It's not controversial and, as I say, this is a very small part of the whole bill and its concept and I would recommend that we move with this amendment, this committee amendment. It is a fair and a reasonable thing and I move the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I understand there is an amendment by Senator Wesely and Senator Wesely is excused. Senator Harris, are you able to handle that or do you know about it?

SENATOR HARRIS: I'm not...

SPEAKER NICHOL: Do you know about it?

SENATOR HARRIS: I knew that Senator Wesely had an amendment but I have not been...talked with him, I have not talked with him about it. He has not visited with me about how he'd like to handle it.
