

SPEAKER NICHOL: Did you say you wish to withdraw it? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Goodrich, would you like to close on it, please.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Mr. President, I think we've hashed and rehashed and discussed and cussed and everything else. Let's just move it forward, thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 4 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Do you have anything to read in, new bills or anything of that nature?

CLERK: Yes, sir, I do. Mr. President, Senator Conway would like to add his name to 955 as co-introducer. (See page 268 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: With no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator DeCamp has amendments to 825 to be printed. Mr. President, Senator Rod Johnson would move to rerefer LB 894. That will be laid over. New bills. (Read LB 969-979 by title for the first time. See pages 268-71 of the Legislative Journal.)

And finally, Mr. President, I have a hearing notice from the Public Works Committee and that is offered by Senator Schmit as Chair.

Mr. President, Senator Barrett would like to add his name to 794 as co-introducer. (See page 272 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: No objection, so ordered.

CLERK: That's all that I have, Mr. President.
