

and I would ask the support of...20,000 pounds on any single axle so it lowers the amount of grain that can be carried, or whatever, and I think it is a good amendment. Senator Beyer agrees with it so I have heard no objection to it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, do you have any comment on the proposed amendment?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I have no objection to that amendment, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Very well, is there further discussion on the Haberman amendment? If not, all those in favor of adopting the Haberman amendment to the committee amendments vote aye, opposed vote no. Do you wish...all members, please record your vote on the Haberman amendment to the committee amendment. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Haberman's amendment to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The committee amendments are thus amended. We are back to the committee amendments as amended. Any further discussion on those? Senator Warner, do you wish to speak on the committee amendments? No. Very well, all those in favor of adopting the committee amendments, Public Works Committee amendments to the bill vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 122.
