CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill,
Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 217A.
Mr. Clerk, do you want to read something in first?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, if I might. Your Committee on
Education offers notice of public hearing for January 21;
Revenue as well for January 21 and January 22, signed by the
respective chairmen.

Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review
reports LB 825 to Select File with E & R amendments. Your
Committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs
reports LB 563 to General File with amendments attached and
that is signed by Senator Landis as Chair. (See
pages 299-300 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1001-1010 by title for
the first time as found on pages 300-2 of the Legislative
Journal.)

Mr. President, I have amendments from Senator Pappas to
LR 57 to be printed. (See pages 302-4 of the Legislative
Journal.)

Senator DeCamp would move that LB 178 be placed on General
File notwithstanding the action of the committee.

And I have notice of hearing from the Judiciary Committee
for Wednesday, January 22 and Tuesday, January 21.

SPEAKER NICHOL: We'll move on to the A bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, the A bill is a bill offered by
Senator Beutler. (Read title.) It was read on March 27
last year. It was referred directly to General File. I do
have amendments pending by Senator Landis. (Landis
amendment appears on pages 305-6 of the Legislative
Journal.)
