CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 643, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Senator Pappas, would you like to take up the A bill now?

CLERK: Mr. President, 643A is a bill by Senator Pappas. (Read.)

SENATOR PAPPAS: I ask for the advancement of the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Any discussion? If not the question is, shall the A bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you care to. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The A bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have some things to put in?

CLERK: Mr. President, I do. I have a new resolution, LR 320 by Senators Baack, Morehead, Nelson, Eret, Vickers. (Read resolution as found on pages 315-16 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President.

Senator Beutler would like to add his name to 474 and Senator Withem to 988.
