CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The committee amendments are adopted. Now, Senator Withem, the bill.

SENATOR WITHEM: The bill then again is a notification requirement when new SIDs are planning...being planned. The bill would now say county planning departments, sheriffs, city planning departments, clerks and election commissioners should also all be notified when a new SID is being formed. That is the bill now after the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. Move on to LB 575.

CLERK: Mr. President, 575 was a bill introduced by Senator Lynch. (Read title.) It was read on January 22 of last year, referred to the Public Works Committee, advanced to General File. There are Public Works Committee amendments pending.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Schmit, were you going to take the Public Works amendments to the bill, please.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I ask you to listen closely because the committee amendment to LB 575 is the bill and we are striking the original section. Senator Lynch, I think, will have more to say about that later. The committee amendment does two things. First, the amendment provides that the picture of the driver on the license shall have a different background color if the driver is a minor. And, second, the amendment provides for an increase in the cost of obtaining a replacement or a duplicate license from the current \$2.00 charge to a charge of \$5.00. I have a clarifying amendment to the committee amendment. This would clarify the fee provisions would apply only to licenses issued or renewed after the effective date of this act. I would urge you to
