

January 21, 1986 LB 645, 647

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. The question is, the withdrawal of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to withdraw the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: LB 647 is withdrawn. Move on to reports. Mr. Clerk. Senator Lamb, can you handle this, please, as Vice-Chairman of Public Works?

CLERK: Senator, we have a confirmation report from the Public Works Committee on the appointments of Fred Hansen, Cliff Langel. The report is on 356 of the Journal.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Lamb, please.

SENATOR LAMB: The committee met and approved these two gentlemen and recommend that this report be adopted by the full body.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. Any further discussion? If not, the question is, the confirmation of the two gentlemen referred to by Senator Lamb. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to adopt the report.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The report is adopted. Move on to General File. Do you have anything to put in first, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Okay. Move on to General File, number nine.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 645 was a bill that was introduced originally by Senators Lowell Johnson, Goodrich and Pappas. Senator Pappas later withdrew his name. (Read.) The bill was read on January 22 of last year. It was referred to the Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee for hearing. The bill was advanced to General File. Mr. President, it was considered in March of last year. I have no amendments pending at this time.
