SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hannibal, please.

SENATOR HANNIBAL: Well, Mr. Speaker, I just say I oppose the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Higgins, did you wish to close on the advancement of the bill, please. Senator Labedz, did you wish to speak again? No? All right. Then you may close, Senator Higgins.

SENATOR HIGGINS: Thank you, Mr. President. I think we spent enough time on this watered down bill. I'll move the advancement of it. Thank you.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. A record vote has been asked for. Please vote if you care to. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read as found on page 450 of the Legislative Journal.) 6 ayes, 32 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill fails to advance. Do you have something to put in, bills to introduce?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SPEAKER NICHOL: May I suggest to you that if you have bills that you wish to introduce...please let me have your attention. (Cavel.) I don't want to disrupt you from what you're doing, but you must have your bills in by noon today, if you wish to introduce bills. So, if you're sitting on one, don't hold it till after lunch, please. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, new bills. (Read LBs 1178-1234 by title for the first time as found on pages 450-62 of the Legislative Journal.)
