SENATOR VICKERS: I didn't ask for a roll call vote. A machine vote is fine.

PRESIDENT: You want a machine vote instead of a roll call?

SENATOR VICKERS: Fine.

PRESIDENT: Machine vote. Senator Nelson and Senator Lamb, please return to the Chamber. We may proceed with a machine vote then? We had not started taking this vote, members, so please record your vote aye or nay. And the motion is to eliminate the sunset provision of LB 124. Record your vote aye or nay. The motion is by Senator Vickers to amend LB 124. Please record your vote. The motion is to amend LB 124 by removing the sunset provision. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 19 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Another amendment? Nothing further on the bill. Senator Johnson. The call of the house is raised. Thank you. Senator Johnson.

SENATOR R. JOHNSON: Mr. President, I would simply move for the advancement of LB 124.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance LB 124 from Select File to Enrollment and Review, or from General File to Enrollment and Review. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay.

SENATOR VICKERS: That is a debatable issue and my light is on.
