

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Mr. President, the A bill is to deal with the increased administrative costs in processing those provisions of the bill that make it impossible for someone whose license has been suspended in another state to get a license in Nebraska. This amendment to the A bill adds an additional half-time slot in order to help the processing of the paper work that is necessary to ascertain whether people in other states have had their license suspended. My recollection is that this is about a \$5,000...five or \$6,000 item. I would ask the adoption of this amendment to the A bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment to 631A. Senator Higgins, excuse me.
