SENATOR HABERMAN: I move to adjourn until 9:00 a.m., Monday morning.

PRESIDENT: We a few matters to read in.

CLERK: Mr. President, priority bill designation by Senator Chronister. I have notice of hearing from the Agriculture and Environment Committee signed by Senator Rod Johnson. Urban Affairs reports LB 808 to General File with committee amendments attached. (See page 603 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Rod Johnson would like to add his name to LB 1230 as co-introducer. Senator Hall...I'm sorry. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports they have carefully examined and engrossed LB 548 and find the same correctly Engrossed. That is signed by Senator Hall.

I have amendments from Senator Pappas and Senator Lamb to LB 275, and Senator Lamb to 753 to be printed. (See page 604 of the Journal.)

I have notice of hearing from the Health and Human Services Committee. That is offered by Senator Wesely as Chair.

Judiciary, Mr. President, reports LB 957 to General File with committee amendments attached. That is signed by Senator Hoagland as Chair. That is all that I have, Mr. President.
