PRESIDENT: The motion is to advance 351 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. LB 275.

CLERK: Mr. President, on 275, there are E & R amendments, Senator.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I would move the E & R amendments be adopted.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion to adopt the amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried.
