So I'd urge you to vote against this so we can get the bill advanced today, if possible, before lunch. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would recognize Senator Chambers, but ask first that the Clerk read matters into the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 988 to Select File, signed by Senator Hall.

Senators DeCamp, Lundy and Hannibal have amendments to 298; Senator Hall to 298; Senator Pappas to 379.

Mr. President, your committee on Ag and Environment whose Chair is Senator Rod Johnson reports 1016 to General File; 227 indefinitely postponed; 443, 463, 617, all indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Rod Johnson.

Mr. President, your Committee on Health and Human Services whose Chair is Senator Wesely reports LB 267 to General File with amendments; 277, General File with amendments; 438, General File with amendments; 572 to General File with amendments. Those are all signed by Senator Wesely.

Mr. President, Senator Sieck would like to add his name to LR 333; Senator Morehead to 1049; Senators Eret and Beutler to LB 91. (See pages 624-30 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.

PRESIDENT: All right. We hope to take care of the Haberman amendment one way or the other. The Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, Senator Hoagland said that Senator Haberman's amendment may be to make a point. That's what laws are for. That's what every amendment is for and what is the point that is being made? It depends on what side of the bill or this issue you're on. Now I was concerned because the truckers and others said for insurance purposes cut entire categories of people out, even though driving is of the very essence of their employment. Now if insurance is the problem, it had been my understanding that emergency vehicles are operated by political subdivisions. They have
