say aye. Opposed. Motion carried. Next bill, Mr. Clerk, LB 471 for Final Reading.

CLERK: (Read LB 471 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR GOLL: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 471 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Has everyone voted who is entitled to vote? Mr. Clerk, please record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as it appears on pages 714-15 of the Legislative Journal.) 38 ayes, 0 nays, 11 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SENATOR GOLL: LB 471 passes. It is my understanding that there is an amendment to be placed on LB 525 by Senator Warner, who has not as yet arrived. It has been requested of the Chair that we pass over LB 525 and move it down to the bottom. Proceed with LB 531, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a motion from Senator Lynch to return LB 531 to Select File for a specific amendment.

SENATOR LYNCH: Thank you, Mr. Chairman and members. I have a friendly amendment. We've discussed this with Senator Withem, the Chairman of the Urban Affairs Committee, and also as a result of speaking with a number of county officials. A technical little problem. Where it says "February" on page 2, lines 6, 14, and 21, we'd like to change the "February" to "March." Simply the reason is that in the court houses in the month of January, when all the work would have to be done to satisfy the term "February" in the bill, it would be very difficult to do the job adequately and prepare the documents that rightfully so this bill demands be prepared. We are asking your consideration for amending the bill, returning it and amending simply those sections that say "February" to "March." Thank you.

SENATOR GOLL: Senator Withem.

SENATOR WITHEM: Mr. President, members of the body, the amendment that Senator Lynch offers is fine with me. The intent of the bill was to get the publication date of the delinquent taxes over the hump of January 1st because a lot of people clear them up as of January 1st.
