PRESIDENT: Motion is to cease debate. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. I see five hands. Motion is, shall the debate cease? Please record your vote. The motion is to cease debate on the Hoagland motion to raise the bill to the floor. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The debate is closed. Forty seconds left on the debate...total debate time. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Can I ask the house go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The request is for the house to go under call. All those in favor of the house coming under call vote aye, opposed vote nay. Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to go under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The house is under call. Members sitting in your seats, please look up to the front board and record your presence, see that your green light is on. Five are excused at the present time. Members outside the Legislative Chamber, please return to the Senate Chamber, the house is under call. Members are properly to be in your seats during the time that the house is under call and unauthorized personnel should not be on the floor. Senator Schmit, please. Senator Withem, Senator Goodrich, Senator Goll, Senator Chizek, Senator Higgins, Senator Landis. Senators Wesely, Landis, Higgins, and Goodrich...Wesely, Landis, Higgins, and Goodrich. Senator Landis and Goodrich...Senators Landis and Goodrich, the house is under call. Please return to the Legislative Chamber. Senator Hoagland, I am going to let you proceed to close. You have about 30 seconds.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: That is fine. Let me go ahead and begin my closing while we are waiting for the remaining senators, Mr. President. As I indicated in my opening, ladies and gentlemen, I brought this bill in on behalf of numerous physicians throughout Nebraska that are very concerned about this problem.
