CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 737-38 of the Legislative Journal.) 23 ayes, 14 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to raise.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. The bill remains in committee. The bill stands indefinitely postponed I guess as a result of this. Okay, next, do you have matters for the record yet, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes, sir. Mr. President, I have a confirmation report from the Health and Human Services Committee. It is offered by Senator Wesely as Chair.

Mr. President, your Committee on Business and Labor whose Chair is Senator Barrett to whom was referred LB 1036 instructs me to report the same back to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; 1037 General File, 1204, General File, 1203 General File with amendments attached, all signed by Senator Barrett as Chair. PRESIDENT: The Call of the house is raised. We are ready for the Pirsch motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Pirsch would move to withdraw LB 1236.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Pirsch.

SENATOR PIRSCH: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body, 1236, while perhaps I will bring it up next year, it is too late in the year to be considered and rather than have it go through the laborious process and not quite make it, I would like to withdraw it now. I hope you will agree with me.

PRESIDENT: Is there discussion on Senator Pirsch's motion? If not, all those in favor of the bill being withdrawn vote aye, opposed vote nay. We are voting on a motion to withdraw LB 1236 requested by Senator Pirsch. Please record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to withdraw the bill.
