SENATOR MARSH PRESIDING

SENATOR MARSH: The Legislature will please rise. We will ask Senator Goll to lead us in devotions this morning. Senator Goll.

SENATOR GOLL: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR MARSH: Thank you, Senator Goll. Roll call.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.
