PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 74 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote. See pages 859-60 of the Legislative Journal.) 41 ayes, 1 nay, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next on Final Reading, LB 275.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 275 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 275 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 860 of the Legislative Journal.) 44 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. We next proceed to LB 351.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 351 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 351 pass? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote. See page 861 of the Legislative Journal.) 46 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed. Next on Final Reading LB 531.
