

advancement of the bill that I had failed to vote? No, I can't?

PRESIDENT: I think it is out of order, Senator. I think that the motion to reconsider the last bill is out of order at this time, until...all right. LB 43, what do we have on the desk on that, Senator...Mr...

CLERK: Mr. President, on LB 43 it was considered yesterday. E & R amendments were adopted. When we left the bill, Mr. President, Senator Chambers and Senator Morehead had moved to reconsider adoption of Senator Warner and Landis's amendment. That motion is presently before us, the motion to reconsider that vote.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Senator Chambers, do you wish to speak on the motion to reconsider?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes. Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I needn't take any time at all in discussing this proposition. I'm in favor of Senator Warner's amendment, but I was in favor of LB 43 without any amendments. So this comes closer to what I think the amounts ought to be in view of the fact that there are, whatever the negotiations, or whatever this process is called, and I was not here in time to cast my vote and this amendment had 24. So that is why I offered the motion to reconsider. I think the amendment has merit. I'm in favor of it and I intend to vote for it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nelson.

SENATOR NELSON: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I have another amendment up there, I just wanted the body to know. I don't think that we need to spend a lot of time on this today. I think most of us know how we feel. I passed out, in case the bill drafter did not have time to get my bill drafted, a sheet that would in essence tell you real shortly what my bill says. If you do not support Senator Warner's or Senator Morehead's reconsideration, my amendment is up there. In essence it is not mine alone, it is Senator Remmers' and mine, you can see what it is. It is eventually 68,000 for the Governor, 62,500 for the Attorney General. Incidentally, Speaker Nichol did ask that the Lieutenant Governor's be considered at a lower amount than what originally we had in. That is by 1990 42,000 and 45,000 for
