

SENATOR PETERSON: Well, I just...I guess not really. It just is an amendment that clarifies that so that it does not put that mental health director, or whoever, from practicing but from at least forbids him from skimming from patients that he might see through that Mental Health Center and it is very evident that this could be very evident that this could happen. So this amendment clears it up and I ask for your adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote if you care to. Let's go. The committee amendments we are voting on. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the committee amendments.
