PRESIDENT: The Clerk reads matters here. We will proceed as long as we have a quorum, I guess, until someone adjourns. Do you have any matters for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, yes, I do. Senator Conway would make a motion to reconsider the action on LR 32.
