New A bill, 277A by Senator Chronister and DeCamp. (Read for the first time by title. See page 927 of the Legislative Journal.)

I have Reference Reports. I have an explanation of vote. I have amendments to 325 from Senator DeCamp. I have notice of hearing from the Ag and Environment Committee. I have a report of Registered Lobbyists for this past week. Amendments to 105 by Senator Lowell Johnson to be printed, and a new resolution by Senator Vard Johnson, LR 347. (Read explanation of resolution. See pages 928-35 of the Legislative Journal.) That will be laid over, Mr. President.

Mr. President, I have a motion on the desk. SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I have talked to as many of you as I can about this, and so the record is clear, the bills are mentioned by number in the motion. They come from the Speaker's Agenda of those bills which were advanced from committee with no committee amendments and no dissenting votes.
