SENATOR MILLER: All right.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the Wesley amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. It requires 25 since we are on Select File. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 10 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. We'll leave this now and move on to LB 122. Would you like to read in something first, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Before we proceed I have notice of hearing from the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee, a confirmation hearing. That is signed by Senator Hefner. I have amendments to be printed by Senator Goll to 355. Confirmation report from the Public Works Committee, that is signed by Senator Schmit. Your Committee on Government reports 875, 876, and 1063 to General File. Those are signed by Senator Landis. New A bill. (Read by title for first time LB 757A, and LB 1060A.) Your Committee on Health and Human Services reports 1055 to General File with amendments. Senator Remmers has amendments to 942. Administrative Rules and Regulations Review Committee reports 449 to General File, 536 indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Hannibal. And Constitutional Revision and Recreation reports 307CA and 314CA as indefinitely postponed. Those are signed by Senator Rupp. Senator Lynch has amendments to LB 903 to be printed. And I have an Attorney General's Opinion to Senator DeCamp to be inserted. (See pages 946-60 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, LB 122 is by Senator Haberman. Senator Hall, I do have E & R amendments, Senator.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move the E & R amendments be adopted.
