**SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING**

**SPEAKER NICHOL:** (Microphone not activated.) ...to the Nebraska Unicameral, the George W. Norris Chamber. We have with us this morning Reverend Harland Johnson. Reverend Johnson. Would you please rise.
