

included. It would obviously have to deal primarily with that kind of research where state policy permits the development of a particular type of food to be grown. So I think it's a separate issue although I certainly understand the overlap that could be there as a limiting type of activity that might be done with food processing. The other side, the animal clinic side, large animal clinic is located, of course, at Clay Center. It is located there because that's where the USDA facility is. There is cooperation with the University of Nebraska. There is several thousand head of large animals there which are essential for clinic training to be held where the animals are and it's a logical place for its location. I think it's a far superior proposal than what we previously considered in the long run, both in terms of cost as well as the kind of training...educational opportunity that will be available for Nebraska students as well as the kind of research that could be conducted there as a part of the, large animal research that could be done as a part of the clinic facility. With that, Mr. President, I'd move the bill be advanced. It's been pointed out as with any new facility, there is some new operating cost. I should point out all this money is not for brick and mortar. About 2 and 1/2 million of it is equipment in those facilities and equipment is exceedingly important in the research and that includes some additional equipment at Scottsbluff. It is not a new building. It is a partial renovation of Filley Hall with some addition onto Filley Hall at the East Campus which again seems the more prudent way to go than a totally brand new structure somewhere.
