provisions of LB 804. It is a very small amount. The committee will be made up of instate people. We don't anticipate that there is going to be a tremendous expense, but we do want them to have at least their travel. That is the purpose of this bill. I would move for the advancement of LB 804A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of LB 804A. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on advancement of 804A.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 829A.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 829A is a bill by Senator Smith. (Read title.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President. The A bill for LB 829 would simply provide start-up funding for the care management bill that was moved from General File the other day. I don't know whether I need to expound upon the amount. It would be funded money that would implement the development of the concept statewide, which is already partially implemented, and then there would be a payback in a very short period of time. I ask the advancement of the A bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 829, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. We'll pass over LB 829A, excuse me. We'll pass over 898A and go on to LB 899A.

CLERK: LB 899A by Senator Rod Johnson. (Read title.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Rod Johnson.
