LB 994, 996, 1131

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance 994.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 996.

CLERK: LB 996 was a bill introduced by Senator Beutler. (Read title.) The bill was read on January 14, referred to the board for hearing, advanced to General File. I have no amendments.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would move for the advancement of this bill. This bill makes minor changes in several sections of the statute which still contain the references to the Budget Committee of the Legislature or Legislative Council. Where these occur in the statutes, LB 996 would substitute the words "Appropriations" to conform to the actual name of this committee. Reference to the Legislative Council Budget Committee are deleted entirely as the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature performs the function of both committees. With that, Mr. President, I would move for the advancement of this bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The question is the advancement of the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Please vote. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 996, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 1131.

CLERK: LB 1131, introduced by Senators Hartnett and Labeledz. (Read title.) It was first read on January 21, referred to Public Works, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
