LB 881, 929

CLERK: LB 881 by Senator DeCamp. (Read title.) It was read on January 9, referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. Senator, I do have an amendment from you on this bill. (DeCamp amendment is found on page 1198 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: We offer the amendment now or not? Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 881 is a bill to promote safety for the public in the interchangeable use of containers not designed for ammonia or LP gas, and the dangers of changing tank carriers for use on the public roads. The amendment is something worked out by absolutely every party to this thing that is involved in any way. It is agreed upon, and it just specifies...it's on page...what page is it?

CLERK: Page 1198.

SENATOR DECAMP: ...specifies what rules and regs will be involved, and who enforces them. It is agreed upon by the Fire Marshal, the fertilizer industry, the transporters, everybody involved. I'd ask adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Question is the adoption of the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the amendment, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The amendment is adopted. Senator DeCamp, on the bill. The motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SPEAKER NICHOL: The bill is advanced. LB 929.

CLERK: Mr. President, 929 was a bill introduced by the Government Committee and signed by its members. (Read title.) It was read on January 10, referred to Government, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.
