CLERK: Mr. President, 1063 offered by the Speaker. (Read title.) Read on January 17, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Nichol.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this simply allows counties of 15,000 or more to charge more than \$3 for license for dogs. I move the advancement of the bill.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance 1063, Mr. President.

CLERK: 1048, Mr. President, by Senator Goodrich. (Read title.) Introduced in January, referred to Retirement for hearing, advanced to General File. I have no amendments pending.
