LB 808, 959, 959A

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lynch, do you want to have a closing?

SENATOR LYNCH: No, I would waive closing, Mr. President. I think we have it adequately covered. I would ask for support to advance this bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The question is, shall LB 959 be advanced as amended? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced as amended. Now we move to LB 959A.

CLERK: 959A by Senator Lynch. (Read title.)

SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator Lynch.

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes, Mr. Chairman, in case anybody did look at the fiscal note, there is an error. It shows money identified under General Fund and in this there is no General Fund monies involved in this. The amendments do provide that the department can charge enough revenue to cover whatever cost exists. There is adequate cash revenues available for whatever cost may be involved with this. I would answer any questions anybody might have.

SENATOR CARSTEN: All those in favor of advancing LB 959A will vote aye, those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes. 0 nays on the motion to advance the A bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill is advanced. Next bill, 1093, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1093 was a bill that was introduced by the...

SENATOR CARSTEN: 1093 was pulled, okay. So then we will move to 808, Mr. Clerk.
