LB 1242, 1247

SENATOR CARSTEN: We're voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The committee amendments are adopted. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: For the reasons earlier stated, colleagues, I'd ask the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The motion is to advance LB 1242 as amended. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed... Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The bill as amended is advanced. LB 1247.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1247 is by Judiciary. (Read title.) Read on January 22, referred to Judiciary, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: LB 1247, Senator Carsten and colleagues, is a bill introduced by the Judiciary Committee on behalf of the State Probation Administration. It's like a number of other bills we have had here today. It is a general clean-up statute for the State Probation Administration. It deals with such technical changes as no longer requiring that the district judges approve the appointment of each employee of the State Probation System, but instead, allow the state probation officer to do that, other changes of a like nature. I'd ask the adoption of the committee amendments and the advancement of the bill.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The motion is to adopt the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CARSTEN: The committee amendments are adopted.
