CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Lynch's amendment to the bill.

New A bill, 1143A by Senator Vard Johnson. (Read by title for the first time. See page 1282 of the Legislative Journal.)

Your Enrolling Clerk has presented to the Governor LB 839 which was read and passed on Final Reading this morning. Enrollment and Review reports 318, 318A, 813, 942, LB 759, LB 788, 890, 925, 925A, 829, 829A, 237, LB 894 and LB 894A all to Select File, some of which have E & R amendments, Mr. President. SENATOR CARSTEN: Senator DeCamp, there is a motion to indefinitely postpone. Do you want to take it up? Or do you want to lay it over? That would automatically lay it over unless you want to take it up. Okay, we will take up the motion to indefinitely postpone. Senator Hoagland.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: Let me withdraw the motion to indefinitely postpone, Mr. President, and simply speak against the bill because it may be that we can save ourselves a little bit of time and I don't think we need the motion to IPP to make up our minds on the bill. So I will withdraw it at this time.
