So I would urge you to kill it.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator DeCamp. This is a motion to indefinitely postpone on Select File. It requires 25 votes. The board will be held open for 30 seconds. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Fifteen seconds left for voting. The Clerk will record. Senator DeCamp. Senator DeCamp asks for a call of the house. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to go under call.

SENATOR LANDIS: We are under call. Please return to your seats, record your presence. There are six officially excused, Senator DeCamp. Senator Barrett, please record, check in. Senators Hannibal and Harris. Senator Lynch. Senator Pirsch and Rogers, please check in. Senators Smith and Withem, please check in. Senator DeCamp, are you prepared to proceed with a roll call vote? Four. The time being eleven fifty-eight, Senator DeCamp, there are three now that are not present. Senators Chambers and Lynch have returned. May we proceed with the roll call, Senator DeCamp. Certainly. The motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 1028. Mr. Clerk, call the roll, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1289 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR LANDIS: While the Clerk is tabulating, let me tell you that there are three more bills that are without amendment that follow this one. I would like to be able to dispense with those before we break for lunch.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to indefinitely postpone.

SENATOR LANDIS: The motion is successful, the bill is killed. We will move to LB 1036. Senator Hall.
