SPEAKER NICHOL PRESIDING

SPEAKER NICHOL: Welcome to the Nebraska Unicameral. We have with us this morning Dr. Robert Palmer of the Westminster Presbyterian Church. Would you please rise.

CLERK: Mr. President, 359, offered by Senator Marsh, found on page 1278 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, 359, on page 1278, is speaking to spinal cord injury. April has been designated as the month of concern for informing the public of the dangers and consequences of spinal cord injury, and how to avoid such injury, and what to do on the scene when such injury occurs. I move that the Nebraska Legislature adopt LR 359 which declares the month of April as Spinal Cord Injury Prevention Month in Nebraska, and that we urge all
