Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hall.

SENATOR HALL: Mr. President, I'd move that LB 277 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB 277. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 277A.
