

March 12, 1986 LB 779, 922

**PRESIDENT:** Senator Hall, would you like to move.

**SENATOR HALL:** I'd move that LB 779 be advanced from Select File to E & R for Engrossing.

**PRESIDENT:** You've heard the motion to advance 779 from Select File. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. The motion carried. The bill is advanced. LB 922.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, 922 is on Select File. It does have E & R amendments.

**PRESIDENT:** Senator Hall.

**SENATOR HALL:** Mr. President, I'd move the E & R amendments be adopted.

**PRESIDENT:** You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Opposed no. Motion carried. The amendments are adopted.

**CLERK:** Mr. President, Senator Wesely would move to amend. Senator Wesely's amendment is on page 895 of the Journal.

**PRESIDENT:** The Chair recognizes Senator Wesely.

**SENATOR WESELY:** Thank you. On LB 922 this is kind of another E & R amendment that Senator Harris just had to put on this other bill. LB 922 deals with the question of mental health funding on Indian reservations and E & R brought down some language clarification that we need to adopt. So, I'd ask approval of this amendment.

**PRESIDENT:** Is there discussion on the Wesely amendment? If not, the motion is to adopt the amendment. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. The motion is the adoption of a motion offered by Senator Wesely to LB 922. Please record your vote. May we have the attention of the membership to the motion before us, please. Have you all voted? Record the vote, Mr. Clerk.

**CLERK:** 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

**PRESIDENT:** The amendment is adopted. Anything further?
