SPEAKER NICHOL: No objections, so ordered.

CLERK: That is all that I have at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Senator Vickers, were you ready to go on LB 1172?

SENATOR VICKERS: Yes, I guess.

SPEAKER NICHOL: Well, if not, we could go 783, but if you are ready, we will take you.
