

Legislature, Dr. J.L. Colburn from Scottsbluff. We very much appreciate your coming down. Welcome. Next is LB 137 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senators DeCamp and Rod Johnson would move to return 137 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment is on page 1119 of the Journal.

SENATOR DECAMP: Why don't we just drop it. We'll negotiate with the Speaker on something on that.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to proceed to other Final Reading matters, first, Mr. Speaker?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Is this the situation where we have amending? Is this Senator Scofield's bill? I suggest we go ahead and read the bill. If there are other things that need to be put on, we have 1007, I understand, which can be put on. And I...

PRESIDENT: There is a motion to bring it back.

SPEAKER NICHOL: I must defend my friends from the west end of the state. We stick together, you know. I would just suggest we go ahead and read the bill.

PRESIDENT: Very well. Proceed with the reading of LB 137 with the emergency clause.

CLERK: (Read LB 137 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 137 pass with the emergency clause attached? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. Please record your vote on final passage of LB 137. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote as found on page 1399 of the Legislative Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 1 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: A sufficient majority having voted in the affirmative, the bill is declared passed with the emergency clause attached. Next is LB 380.
