LB 325A, 529, 898A

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Yes, the amendment is now adopted. Speaker Nichol, do you have a point that you wish to raise?

SPEAKER NICHOL: Yes. Mr. Chairman, members, let's run those four A bills before lunch, shall we, then we'll adjourn.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: I'll be sure we get the four A bills run before lunch. We need to readvance LB 529 to E & R Final. Senator Hoagland, would you make the motion please.

SENATOR HOAGLAND: I move to readvance LB 529 to E & R Final.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: All in favor signify by saying aye, please. The bill is readvanced. Now Senator Nichol wants me to run four A bill before lunch. All right. So we will start with LB 325, and there is an A bill to that introduced by Senator John DeCamp. Do you wish to make any comment, Senator DeCamp, on the A bill to 325? (LB 325A.)

SENATOR DECAMP: Only that we need to advance the bill, and I'm going to get together with some people to see if we're ever going to go ahead with any form of a pension plan, or whatever. This is not the time or place to decide that issue. We'll get that done some time in the next couple days. But technically you need the A bill for the other portions.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: Thank you, Senator DeCamp. There are no lights on on LB 325A, therefore we're going to ring it up. Record, please.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the motion to advance the A bill.

SENATOR V. JOHNSON: The A bill to 325 is now advanced. Incidentally, we are now on General File. So we are no longer under call, and the rope can come down at the rear of the Chamber, and people can move about with caution. The next A bill is LB 898A. Rod Johnson is the sponsor of that bill. Senator Johnson, would you make comments, please.
